ABOUT TIMBERLINE

Timberline is known for world-class skiing, snowboarding, culinary experiences and the historic Timberline Lodge. The lodge, which stands on the south slope of Mount Hood at an elevation of 6,000 feet, was built in 1937 as part of President Franklin D. Roosevelt's Works Progress Administration to provide relief through public employment during the Great Depression. This beautiful 55,000-square-foot structure rises out of a pristine alpine landscape and is still being used for its original intent — a magnificent ski lodge and mountain retreat for everyone to enjoy. Legendary and awe-inspiring, it's a tribute to the rugged spirit of the Pacific Northwest. Declared a National Historic Landmark in 1977. Timberline is one of Oregon's most popular tourist attractions, drawing nearly two million visitors every year.

In addition to skiing and snowboarding, Timberline appeals to many other outdoor enthusiasts, including mountain bikers and hikers. A vast majority of visitors come for the overall experience, to soak up the natural beauty of Mount Hood, take a tour of the historic lodge and enjoy a meal in one of Timberline's many restaurants.

With so many things to do and see, Timberline Lodge remains a top destination for locals and tourists, all year long.
